



Go System Launch New Range of Innovative Stoves for 2010

Cheshire based Go System are set to launch 5 new innovative stoves to their range in 2010. Three cartridge stoves and two remote feed stoves will be available.

CARTRIDGE STOVES:

The lightest in the range is the Go System Fly. Made from Titanium this will be the lightest cartridge stove on the market. Weighing just 50g! This stove will answer the growing need for lighter weight kit and is perfectly suited to weight conscious backpackers.



Scion

The other two cartridge stoves are the Venture and the Scion. Both have folding serrated pan supports and precision flame control. The Scion is exactly the same size as the Fly although it is not made from Titanium and is therefore 32g heavier.

REMOTE FEED STOVES:

The Sirocco is a stable 'large footprint' performance stove ideal for family camping when stability is all important to prevent any pan spillages with children around. The stoves Auto-start piezo igniter means a flame is only a click away. The Sirocco also folds up neatly for easy storage and transportation.

The Apollo is the largest of the new stoves and has a built in wind protector. It includes a remote auto-start piezo igniter attached to the top of the hose. This stove can operate on liquid or vapour gas via a braided hose and pre-heating tube.
